Raoul Mora

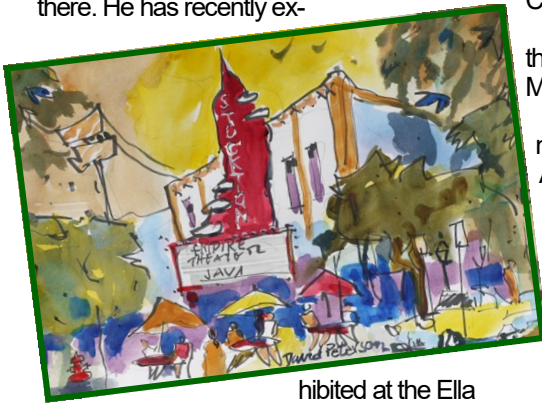

Over the past twenty-five years he has assembled a collection of books and printed materials about Mexican and Mexican-American art, history and culture.

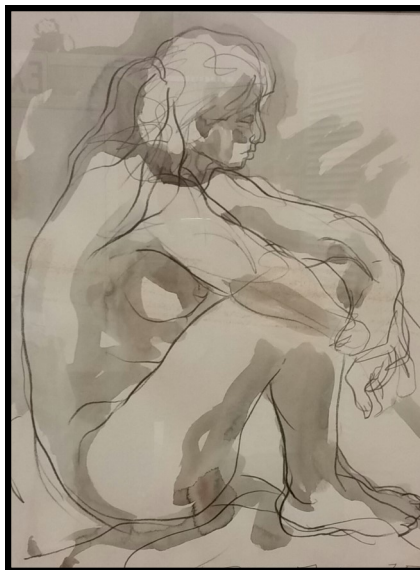
Raoul was a co-founder of the Mexican Heritage Center in Stockton and has been the recipient of the Stockton Arts Commission STAR Award.
